HVAC Equipment:

Provide and install (8) Tempstar 5 ton, 460V 3PH, (2) Tempstar 5 ton, 230V 3PH and (1) Tempstar 230V 1PH, standard efficiency heat pump package units with vertical discharge economizers. Provide and install (4) Trane 10T, 230V 3PH, standard efficiency, heat pump package units with horizontal discharge economizers. All economizers shall comply with California title 24 requirements. Fabricate and provide new sheet metal transition ductwork and fittings and/or curb adapters as required by the installation. Provide and install new condensate ptraps and fittings as required to adapt the new equipment to the existing condensate lines. Provide and install new electrical whips and appurtenances. Connect new equipment to existing temperature control devices.

Miscellaneous:

Provide crane service and equipment rental as required set equipment and install ductwork.

Warranty: 5 years on the compressor, 1 year on parts, 1 year on labor.

CA Contractors License #649196. DIR Registration #100017221. Labor rates are priced at current California prevailing wage rates for Imperial County. Proposal assumes that the work shall be performed during normal working hours (first shift). If afterhours, Saturday, Sunday and/or holiday work is required, additional costs will apply. It is acknowledged that during construction, there may be situations that are beyond the control of the contractor, that were not apparent during the site visit or reasonably inferable from the RFP documents/addendum provided by HUSD that may result in additional work that will require contract price modification by change order. Any work involving extra costs will be executed only upon written and approved change orders. Any delays caused by others shall be subject to additional costs and shall be charged accordingly. Crane costs, lifting and rigging is included. A hazardous materials report was not available at the time of quotation preparation. Any necessary hazardous material abatement that may be required is excluded. Excludes payment and performance bonding. Excludes builders risk insurance. Excludes integration or any scope associated with the fire alarm system. Equipment availability and lead times are beyond the control of contractor. The Trane 10T package units have an approximate 28 week lead time. The RFP deadline for performance will need to be modified if this proposal is accepted.

This proposal may be withdrawn by us if not accepted within 30 days.
