Inter-district Attendance, Academic, & Citizenship Contract

We, the parent(s), or legal guardian(s) of _____, in _____ (grade level) have requested the inter-district transfer of the above-named student into the Holtville Unified School District (District) for the 2024-2025 school year.

In addition to the District's and School's regular policies, regulations and rules, inter-district transfer students must meet the following specific conditions:

ATTENDANCE:

Absences: Students are allowed no more than ten (10) excused or three (3) unexcused, unjustifiable absences during the school year.

Tardies: Students are allowed no more than five (5) unexcused, unjustifiable tardies during the school year.

Dismissal: Students must be retrieved from school at their dismissal time. Students not retrieved from school within fifteen (15) minutes of their dismissal time must be signed out by the parent/guardian at the school office.

ACADEMIC:

Students in grades 7-12 must maintain at least a 2.0 cumulative grade point average. All work must be satisfactory or above at the TK-6 level.

CITIZENSHIP:

Students with repeated disciplinary referrals and/or suspensions will have their inter-district permit revoked.

We have received and understand the District policy regarding inter-district transfer and we understand and agree to all of the following:

- The District reserves the right to revoke the inter-district transfer permit if the student fails to adhere to the District's and the school's standards, policies and rules during his/her attendance in the District, including the conditions set forth above.
- Transportation is not generally available to students enrolled pursuant to an inter-district transfer permit.
- Falsification of any information on the application for an inter-district transfer is cause for immediate revocation of an inter-district transfer approval and no further application will be considered.
- An inter-district petition approval is valid for the period of time for which it is issued. Furthermore, it is valid only while the conditions stated in the request are maintained and will be in force only as long

as the pupil's attendance, citizenship, and scholarship are satisfactory to maintain district behavior standards.

- All inter-district petitions shall be reviewed annually and decision whether to renew or deny will be made by the Superintendent based on Board Policy 5039 and district enrollment patterns.
- The District Superintendent or designee may revoke an inter-district transfer permit at any time during the school year by providing written notice to the parent/guardian at the address on file with District.
